Responsibilities of the Jackson Public School District

(A parent, legal guardian, or custodian will sign the scholar's choice card to indicate initial approval of the scholar's course selection(s). As noted in the state-approved criteria, an unconditional written recommendation from the scholar's high school principal and/or guidance counselor is required for college course scheduling to be accepted and processed.)

(Scholars dually enrolled must complete a college transcript request form and pay the fee for such service upon enrollment. The scholar and parent will also sign a form giving permission for the college to issue a copy of mid-term and end of course grades to the school. The college may be asked by the individual scholar to print their mid-term grades and place in a sealed envelope for the scholar to deliver to the school or mail to the school for recording in the grading system and for parent notification.)
